ORDER

Defendant CACI Premier Technology, Inc. has filed a Motion to Stay Proceedings

Pending Filing and Disposition of a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari [Dkt. No. 1314], which the

plaintiffs oppose. Although the Court appreciates the plaintiffs' being frustrated by further delay

of a civil action which was filed over ten years ago and had advanced to the verge of trial, the

defendant's motion has merit. If certiorari is not granted, the delay of the jury trial will most

likely be for a few months. Should certiorari be granted, there will be a longer delay, but that

would also suggest that the Supreme Court might resolve issues which could have material

effect on the litigation.

To avoid unnecessarily expending attorney and judicial resources, which could be mooted by the Supreme Court's action, defendant's Motion to Stay [Dkt. No. 1314] is GRANTED, and it is hereby

ORDERED that this civil action be and is STAYED until further Order of the Court.
